

Nanane Sawada is a 15-year-old, award-winning violinist who relocated from Japan to the United States in 2023.

In Japan, she received the Grand Prize and the Prize of the Board of Education of Kariya City at the 8th Kariya Music International Competition. She also won First Prize at the Osaka Competition of the 76th Student Music Concours of Japan and was selected as a Finalist at the national level (2022). In addition, she earned First Prize at the 12th Qualia Music Competition.

After moving to the United States, Nanane was awarded First Prize at the Sejong Music Competition and First Place at the 35th Annual Music Festival in Honor of Confucius. In 2026, she won the SBC Concerto Competition. She also participated in the Heifetz International Music Institute in 2024, further expanding her musical training and performance experience.

Nanane has studied violin with Marie Hamana and Ryoko Tanabe, and is currently studying under Desirée Ruhstrat.
